



## Revision of the Memorandum of Cooperation between the European Food Safety Authority and the Food Safety Commission of Japan

THE EUROPEAN FOOD SAFETY AUTHORITY (EFSA) OF THE EUROPEAN UNION, REPRESENTED BY DR. BERNHARD URL, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

AND THE FOOD SAFETY COMMISSION OF JAPAN (FSCJ), REPRESENTED BY DR. YAMAMOTO SHIGEKI, CHAIRPERSON accept the following revisions of the Memorandum of Cooperation (MoC) between EFSA and FSCJ signed on 15 October 2015.

## 1. Reference to Regulation (EC) No 178/2002

Reference to "Regulation (EC) No 178/2002" will be replaced throughout the MoC by the following: "Regulation (EC) No 178/20021."

### 2. Revisions of specific points of the MoC

The following points of the MoC will be replaced as follows:

- Reference to "Article 33 of Regulation (EC) No 178/2002" in point 1.a. of the MoC will be replaced by the following:
  - "Regulation (EC) No 178/20021 and in particular Articles 22, 23 and 33 thereof"
- Reference to "Regulation (EC) No 178/2002, as well as Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 on public access to documents and Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 on the protection of personal data" in point 3 c. of the MoC will be replaced by the following:
  - "Regulation (EC) No 178/2002<sup>2</sup>, with Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 on public access to documents<sup>3</sup>, Regulation (EC) No 1367/2006 on the application of the provisions of the Aarhus Convention<sup>4</sup> and with Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725 on

- Reference to "Article 9(6) of Regulation (EC) No 45/2001" in point 4.c. of the MoC will be replaced by the following:

"Chapter V of Regulation (EU) No 2018/17256"

### 3. Commencement of revisions of the MoC

The abovementioned revisions will commence on the date of signature by both EFSA and FSCJ.
